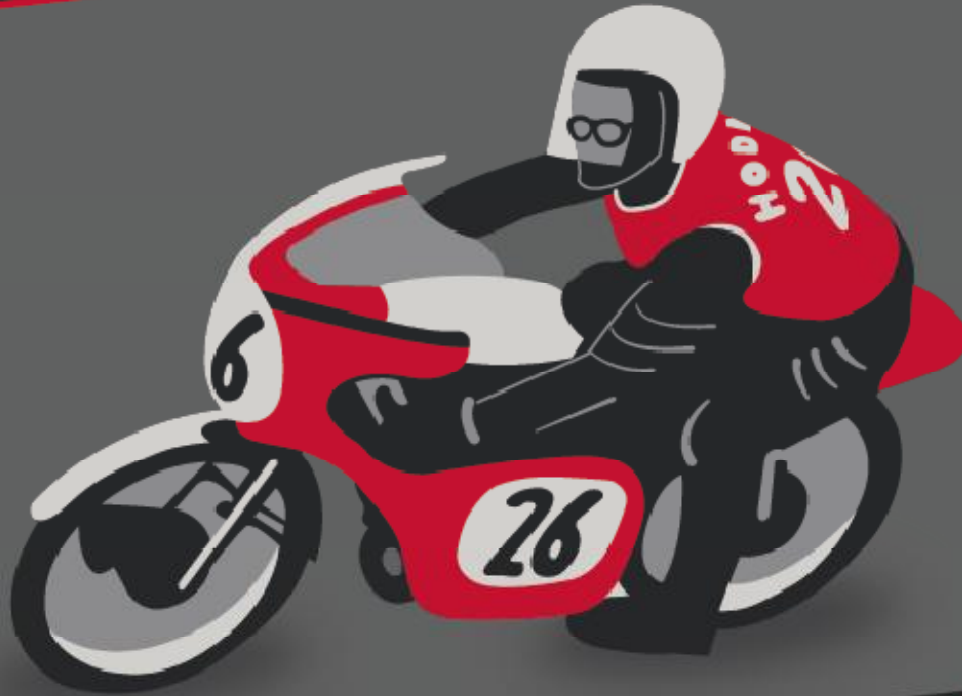

Due to construction, the ride will start at the Perrine Farm at 78573 McLean Road, on the southern edge of town. Registration begins at 9:00 AM. 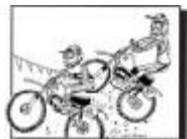

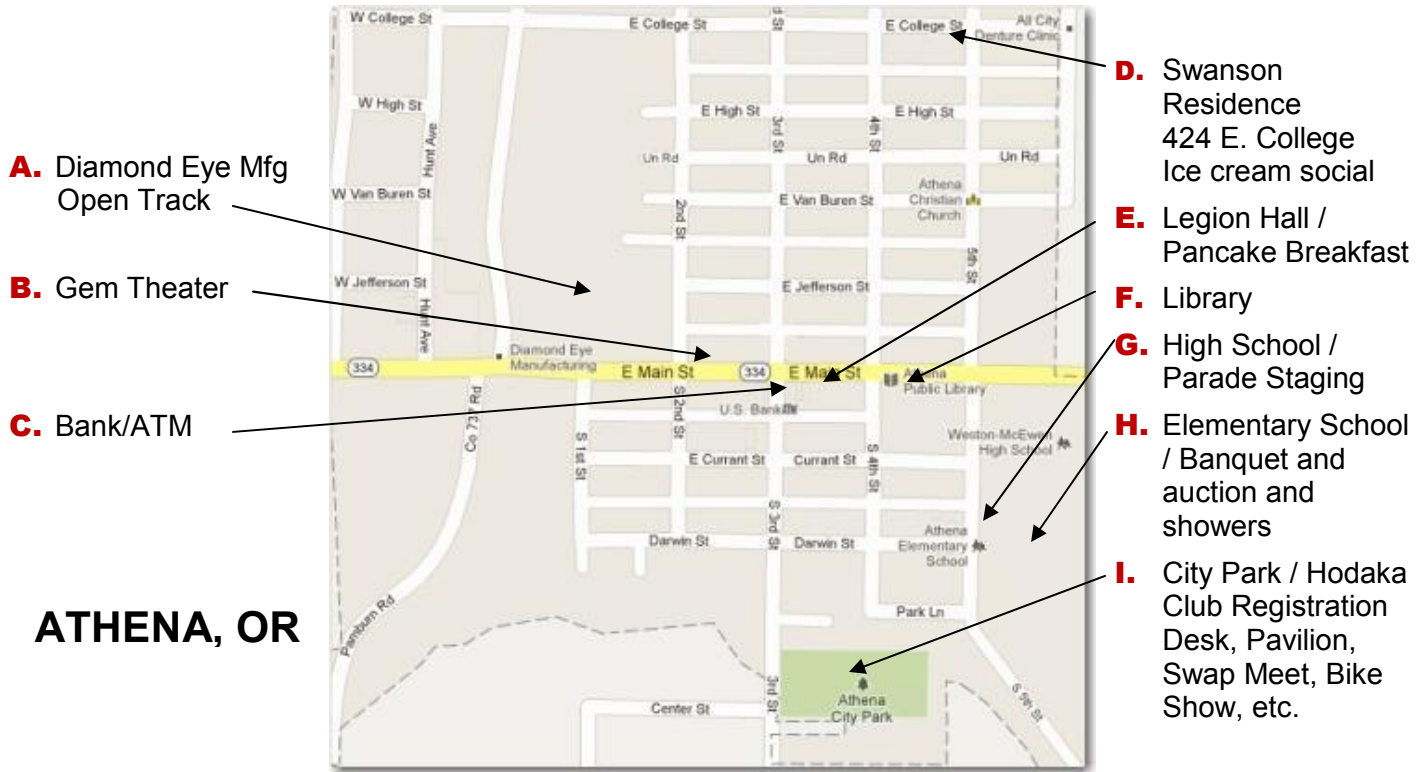

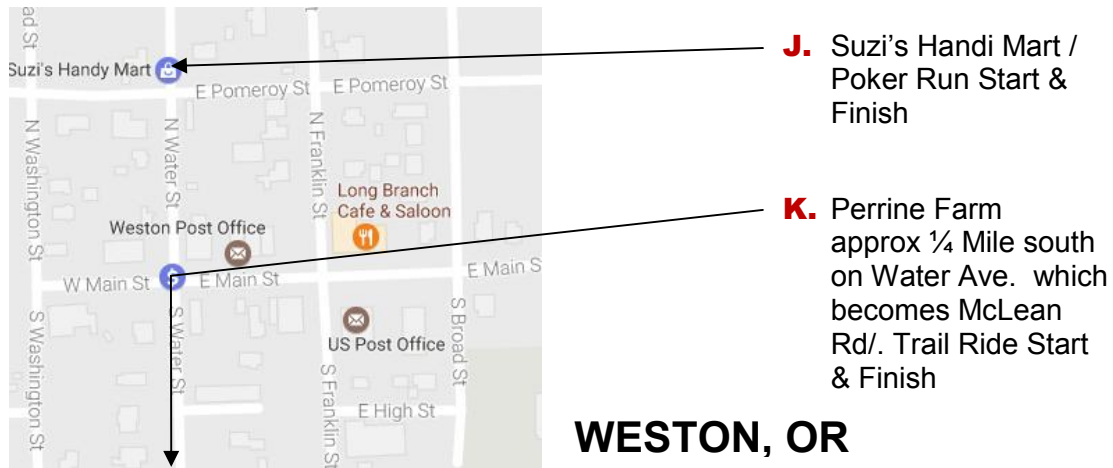

There is NO RACING and unsafe riders will be removed.
